- Are your Stakeholders worried about cyber security?
- Could you get public scrutiny or reputation impact from a security incident?
- Could you get fines or regulatory repercussions?

### **Security management:**

- Are you aware of any security incidents in the past?
- Have you done any threat or risk assessments?
- Have you implemented any controls to mitigate?
- Have you assessed your suppliers from a security perspective?
- Have your employees been trained on good security practices?
- Do you have relevant and adequate company policies for security in place?
- Is there a security architecture for your IT systems?
- Do you have adequate access controls to your systems?
- Does top management or the BOD review the security situation from time to time?
- Do you have anyone specifically responsible for cyber security?
